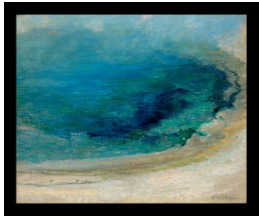

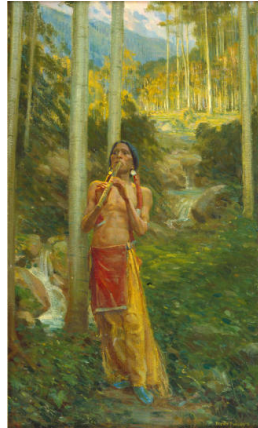

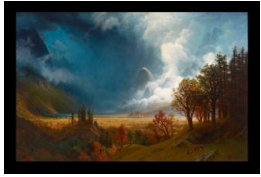

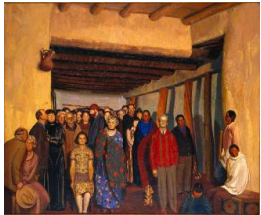

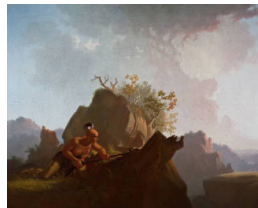

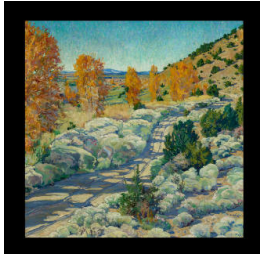


Title: Halting to Smoke
